My desire to write a wonderful newsletter article took me away from seeking God's company as an end in itself, into seeking God as a means to another end: a good article.

God is never a means to our ends. He will not be used for our glory. In fact, He will not be used at all! Our God, Jesus, is not one whom we can order or cajole or manipulate for the purpose of getting what we want – even if it is a helpful thing like a newsletter article about God!

This week, this month, this day, let us put our agendas for God aside. Let's ask to hear Him, not for what we can get, but, instead, simply for who He is. Let's just seek His company. Maybe then we will hear His voice, even if it is a mild rebuke for an out -of-focus pastor.
