As I continue to meander my way through Isaiah, I am continually reminded of the sovereignty of God over the nations. Time and time again, God has Isaiah prophecy over the nations – Assyria, Moab, Edom, Syria, Egypt, and Israel – all the major players of the ancient near-east at the time. There is even a chapter (30) of “Woe to the obstinate nations”!

What becomes abundantly clear is that the earth belongs to God. Land, boundaries, and abundance are God’s to give... and to take away. Every one of these nations believed, at some point, that they were in control of their destinies. That they determined their wealth and wellness. That they were manifestly destined to rule over their part of the earth. That even God was on their side while not on the side of others.

God, however, makes it very clear that none of those beliefs are true. We read about that in Isaiah 14:21,

The LORD Almighty has sworn, “Surely, as I have planned, so it will be, and as I have purposed, so it will stand.

The sovereignty of God over the nations becomes even more clear in Isaiah 14:26-27,

This is the plan determined for the whole world; this is the hand stretched out over all nations. For the LORD almighty has purposed, and who can thwart Him? His hand is out and who can turn it back?

And again we read in Isaiah 17:12-14a,

Oh, the raging of many nations—they rage like the raging sea! Oh, the uproar of the peoples—they roar like the roaring of great waters! Although the peoples roar like the roar of surging waters, when He rebukes them they flee far away, driven before the wind like chaff on the hills, like tumbleweed before a gale. In the evening, sudden terror! Before the morning, they are gone!

There is certainly no mistaking who is in charge of the world! It is God!

Though these words are words of rebuke and warning to the nations, they are words of encouragement and comfort to those of the nations who know, serve, and are submitted to God. They are words of encouragement to us! God, the ruler and Sovereign of the world, rules in favor of His people. We do not need to be discouraged or disconsolate about the future when we know that God controls that future. We do not need to be led into thinking that the world is

spinning out of control and we are doomed. No. That is simply not true. For a time, God lets the world spin by its own force, but He determines the number of revolutions, and He determines the force of the spin.

He is God. He is in control. And, as the song rightly says, "He's got the whole world in His hands." It was true during the days of Isaiah, and it is true for the days we now live in.
